## Segment One Layout

- Prestige Driving School will provide a minimum of 24 hours of classroom instruction, 6 hours of behind-the-wheel (BTW) instruction, and 4 hours of observation time. Classroom instruction must be a minimum of 3 weeks in length. BTW instruction shall not begin until the student has received a minimum of 4 hours of classroom instruction. BTW must be completed no later than 3 weeks after the classroom instruction has been completed.
- 2. Prestige Driving School will conduct the behind-the-wheel instruction in a dual controlled, fully insured automobile, covering each student enrolled in the program.
- 3. Successful completion of the course will meet previously mentioned class, driving, and observation time requirements. In addition, the student will need to have all assignments turned in, maintain at least a C average with class material, and pass the state test with a score of at least 70%.
- 4. The 6 hours of driving will allow the student to gain experience driving in six different environments residential, rural, highway, freeway, light city, and city. Additionally, the students will be on a range gaining valuable experience for general control, backing, turns, intersections, and various types of parking.
- 5. Upon fulfillment of the course, the student will be issued a certificate of completion, which would then be exchanged for a Level 1 driving permit at the Secretary of State office.

## <u>Terms</u>

- 1. The parent/guardian authorizes the student to take part in the program on the basis that the student meets the requirements specified by law for issuance of a motor vehicle operator's license. In addition to requirements of age and vision, the parent/guardian also believes that the child is physically and emotionally ready for this undertaking.
- 2. Total cost for the course is \$450. A \$50 non-refundable deposit is due when registering. Full payment is required by the first day of class. There is a \$25 charge for all returned checks. Replacement certificates will incur a \$20 charge. Fees can be paid in the form of cash or check.

## Attendance/Refund Policy

The student is expected to be in class each and every day. One absence from class for an excused reason will be allowed upon communication between the instructor and parent or guardian. This absence will need to be made up. There will be a \$35 charge for any missed drives without prior arrangements. Each missed range will result in a \$35 fee. If a student withdraws within the first two days, he/she will receive a 50% refund. After two days of class, or any BTW experience, no refund will be given.
